What are rapid antigen tests (RATs)?

RATs are quick diagnostic tools that detect if the COVID-19 antigens are present. They can identify infection after initial exposure to the virus, so that you can seek medical help before symptoms progress.





When should I use the test kit?

You should use it after potential exposure to COVID-19 regardless of the presence of symptoms! Since most of the COVID-19 symptoms are similar to those of other diseases (e.g. the flu, the common cold), you should also use it when you show symptoms to see if you are infected.






How do RATs work?

It's quick and simple! Samples are taken through throat and/or nasal swabs. Our CO-Check test kit only requires you to do a painless nasal swab at the comfort and safety of your own home. The results are then available within 15 minutes.
